For those staying for the School, the suggestion for Wednesday afternoon is to visit Taipei <u>https://en.wikivoyage.org/wiki/Taipei</u> including the National Palace Museum <u>https://www.npm.gov.tw/</u> If you stay in Hsinchu on Saturday, you can explore cities/towns on the West Coast in the south. One possibility is Taichung <u>https://en.wikivoyage.org/wiki/Taichung</u> with the Confucius Temple <u>https://www.taichung.guide/taichung-confucius-temple/</u> From there you can travel to a seaside town (with many temples) called Lukang <u>https://www.taichung.guide/lukang-travel-guide/</u> Further south is Tainan <u>https://en.wikivoyage.org/wiki/Tainan</u> but the schedule is a bit tight for a day trip. If you wish to go to Kenting, you need at least a whole weekend.

From Jinshan you can travel along the East Coast south by a local bus to Keelung <u>https://en.wikivoyage.org/wiki/Keelung</u> a port city. Further south by trains, you have Yilan <u>https://en.wikivoyage.org/wiki/Yilan</u> Taroko George <u>https://en.wikivoyage.org/wiki/Taroko Gorge</u> Hualien <u>https://en.wikivoyage.org/wiki/Hualien</u> although you probably need more than a day for the last two. You can certainly explore these places after the Conference. (But participants from mainland China need to declare their daily whereabouts truthfully in the application for entrance.)
